Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first employing 4 people. Product sales for their initial year of operation amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various parts. During 5 years of operation, the business had expanded to forty employees and their annual sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is among the top global producers within the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. All through the last 60 years, the trade of material handling has developed into a really sophisticated area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its development. Cascade presently continues to grow as the best supplier of lift truck attachments and numerous associated items. The company feels confident in their capability to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining aggressive in the world market.

Through the 1950's, Cascade began to fabricate, design, and advertise its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was built in 1956, to be able to accommodate all of the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current head office. After fifteen years of business, total employees reached 180 employees and sales had reached almost \$2,300,000.

The next manufacturing plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. 1960 marked Cascade's initial move into the international world of the material handling industry as the business established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The company has expanded its production plants throughout the U.S. with areas in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Ohio, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade merchandise are fabricated internationally thanks to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to acquiring 5 corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide leader in forks.
